## Obtaining Fully Licenced IPM Accreditation Level

This is the highest level of accreditation. A facility is awarded the status of Fully Licenced IPM Accreditation when they have met the requirements of Introductory IPM Accreditation (passed a Full Desk Audit) and successfully completed an On-Site Audit (See: Requirements for an On-Site Audit).

The purpose of the On-Site Audit is to allow the auditor to validate the information and materials previously forwarded by the facility in their Full Desk Audit.

Facilities that successfully pass the requirements of an On-Site Audit are designated as Fully Licenced IPM Accredited and will be acknowledged on the Plant Health Atlantic web site and be allowed to display the Plant Health Atlantic – IPM Accredited logo. Only those facilities that meet these requirements will be authorized to use the Plant Health Atlantic – IPM Accredited logo on education material, vehicles and equipment, promotion and marketing materials.

Each golf course facility, franchise, location, branch office, or business that is applying for Fully Licenced IPM Accreditation must request and pass a separate On-site Audit and employ a separate IPM Program Coordinator.

Requests for an On-Site Audit are made directly with the Plant Health Atlantic Administrator.
