NB Environment Update on Fiesta Impact on 50% Rule

- ▶ Since Fiesta labels specify it may need to have at least a second application and up to 4 applications a season to a property to be considered effective, NB Environment and Local Government **are good with the landscaper counting follow up reapplications in with the first.**
- ▶ Meaning that if the original estimate of the treatment percentage of that property with Fiesta was calculated to be 20%, using that same product again in roughly the same areas of the property would not bump up the 20% any.
